

Rules for accommodation in connection with the epidemiological situation (COVID-19)

I.

In accordance with the Operating Rules of Accommodation Services TUO_LEG_10_003 as amended and in accordance with the valid legislation, this notification is issued, which regulates the rules for accommodation in VŠB-TUO accommodation services facilities in connection with the epidemiological situation (COVID-19).

II.

1. All new interested in accommodation must sign the Statutory declaration in connection with the epidemiological situation (COVID-19) (see Annexe 1). It does not apply to those interested who submit a RT-PCR test for the presence of SARS CoV-2 (hereinafter "PCR Test")
2. The rules for accommodation of foreign nationals are governed by the issued rules for entry into the territory of the Czech Republic (CR) according to the protective measure of the Ministry of Health of the Czech Republic (MH CR) as amended. The rules are available on the website of the Ministry of the Interior of the Czech Republic <https://www.mzcr.cz/ochranne-opatreni-omezeni-prekrozeni-statni-hranice-ceske-republiky-s-ucinnosti-od-15-2-2021-do-odvolani>.
2. 1. Accommodation of citizens from countries for which a **PCR test is required upon entry into the Czech Republic** on the basis of a protective measure of the MH CR is governed by the following instructions:
 - a) before entering the territory of the Czech Republic, all persons fill in the Public health passenger locator form, which is available on the website www.prijezdovyformular.cz
 - b) persons who have stayed for more than 12 hours in the last 14 days in the territory of states that are **on the list of countries with a medium risk of COVID-19 according to point III.1** of the above protection measure must have a written confirmation accredited before entering the Czech Republic laboratories that test negative for antigen or RT-PCR; the antigen test must be performed no more than 24 hours and the RT-PCR test no more than 72 hours before the start of the journey
 - c) persons who have stayed for more than 12 hours in the last 14 days in the territory of states that are **on the list of countries with a high risk of COVID-19 according to point III.1** of the above protection measure must have a written confirmation of an accredited laboratories that test negative for antigen or RT-PCR; the antigen test must be performed no more than 24 hours and the RT-PCR test no more than 72 hours before the start of the journey. It is required to **pass the PCR test in the Czech Republic, no later than 5 days after entering** the Czech Republic.
 - d) persons who have stayed for more than 12 hours in the last 14 days in the territory of states that are **on the list of countries with a very high risk of COVID-19 according to point III.1** of the above protection measure must have written confirmation before entering the Czech Republic accredited laboratories with a negative result of an RT-PCR test carried out not more than 72 hours before the start of the journey. **It is required to pass the PCR test in the Czech Republic, at the earliest 5 days after entering** the Czech Republic.

- e) for persons according to point 2.1. letter c) and d) **until the completion of the PCR test on the territory of the Czech Republic, accommodation will be provided** in the reserved areas of the VŠB-TUO dormitories.
- f) the result of the PCR test must be submitted to the employees of the Accommodation Services by the citizen immediately, but no later than within 3 days after receipt of the test result.
- g) until the submission of a valid PCR test, the ban on free movement within the territory of the Czech Republic and the obligation to wear respiratory protective equipment (mask) apply. Prohibition of free movement means restrictions on movement, with the exception to procure basic necessities, medical examination, school and employment, until the result of the PCR Test is presented to Accommodation Services staff.

III.

If any government regulation or Regional hygienic station regulation is in conflict with this regulation, both accommodated persons and employees are always governed by a government regulation or Regional hygienic station regulation.

This notice takes effect on 18.2.2021 and repeals the previous notice USSS_SDE_20_010 Rules for accommodation in connection with COVID-19.

STATUTORY DECLARATION

I declare that:

- I have not suffered in the last three weeks and have not suffered from a deterioration in health in the sense of cough, difficulty breathing or fever, feelings of general weakness or pain in muscle groups or more joints on the day of signing this statutory declaration,
- have not stayed more than 12 hours in the last 14 days in a country that is not on the current list of countries with a low risk of COVID-19.

I further declare that the information in this statutory declaration is true and I have not intentionally withheld any information I know and that I am aware that by providing false information in this statutory declaration I may seriously endanger the health or even the lives of other persons moving indoors. VŠB-TUO. I am further aware that by knowingly providing false information, I am exposed to the risk of criminal prosecution for the spread of contagious human disease according to §152 and §153 of Act.
