



Emergency measures - accommodation operation

I.

Based on an extraordinary measure of the Ministry of Health, I declare:

- 1) **Dormitories can accommodate students who fall under the exceptions according to valid the extraordinary measures of the Ministry of Health.**

Valid the extraordinary measures of the Ministry of Health are available on the website <https://koronavirus.mzcr.cz/category/mimoradna-opatreni/>.

Students who are entitled to accommodation on the basis of government resolutions will sign the "Statutory declaration" upon arrival at the dormitory and hand it over to the reception staff.

- 2) **Students who cannot use dormitory accommodation on the basis of the extraordinary measures, will be charged a discount of 80% on accommodation until the end of extraordinary measures of the Ministry of Health.**

In the event of release of extraordinary measures of the Ministry of Health, the full amount of dormitory fees will be charged FROM THE DATE OF RELEASE IN EXTRAORDINARY MEASURES concerning accommodation in university dormitories.

The discount does not apply to foreign students and students who have signed the **Statutory declaration**.

- 3) **Prohibition of consumption of alcoholic beverages** in kitchens and common areas of dormitories. No more than 10 people can stay in the kitchen at the same time. **The kitchens in all buildings will close at 21:00**, and will be available again from 5:00. If necessary, the student can borrow the keys of the kitchen between 21:00 and 5:00 at individual receptions upon presentation of an identification card (ISIC card).
- 4) **Prohibition of gathering** in the corridors and in other parts of the dormitories in more than **10 people. Prohibition of gathering in the accommodation dwellings** in more than **6 people**. The students who are accommodated in the accommodation dwelling are responsible for it and they will be automatically sanctioned for non-compliance.
- 5) **The obligation to wear respiratory protective equipment** (nose, mouth) in all internal areas of the dormitory area (ie in all common corridors, stairs, kitchens, etc.). In accordance with the measure, only a respirator meeting the requirements set out in the measure (eg FFP2 or CN 95 respirator) is considered a respiratory protective device. The obligation to wear respiratory protective equipment does not apply to accommodation dwellings, provided that only accommodated students of this cell are currently located on the accommodation dwelling.
- 6) **It will be possible to enter the buildings as follows:**
 - Entrance to building "E" only through the main entrance - the corridor to building "D" will be permanently closed.
 - Entrance to buildings "B, C, D" will be only through the reception "AB"
 - The entrance door to the buildings "C, D" will only serve as an escape door and you will not be able to enter the buildings through the identification card.

All accommodated persons are obliged to present an ISIC card - identification card every time they enter the dormitory buildings and also at any time on request by an employee of the Accommodation Services and Guard Services and have the staff checked to see if the person

concerned has the option of staying in the dormitories at the time the ban is imposed. Otherwise, the stay in dormitories will not be allowed.

- 7) **Prohibition of receiving visitors (strangers in dormitories).** An exception in receiving visitors must be agreed with the building manager.
- 8) **The operation of gyms and table tennis rooms is limited so** that in the interior there must not be more than 1 person per 15 m² of indoor sports surface and more than 2 persons in a group, with visitors being obliged to maintain distances of at least 2 meters, if they are not persons from a common household.

The maximum number of persons present in individual indoor sports areas is determined as follows:

- gym E011 - 4 people
- mirror hall E132 - 5 people
- table tennis rooms - 2 people

II.

In case of non-compliance with point I., a fine of up to CZK 5,000 will be imposed. In the event of a very serious violation and the need to call the Police of the Czech Republic or a repeated offense, the students' accommodation contract will be canceled.

III.

USSS executives are required to ensure that their subordinates are demonstrably familiar with this director's order.

IV.

If any decision of the Ministry of Health, government regulation or Regional hygienic station regulation is in conflict with this regulation, both accommodated persons and employees are always governed by decision of the Ministry of Health, government regulation or Regional hygienic station regulation.

This order also cancels the director's order USSS_PRI_21_003.

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
